



Phoenix Alumnae Panhellenic Scholarship Application ***Frequently Asked Questions***

If you are applying for a Phoenix Panhellenic Scholarship, please read through the entire application before beginning. It will help in entering in any information and responses.

Be as specific as you can be throughout the application.

Application Question #23: When listing academic honors/awards, include all; not just those applicable to your sorority.

Application Question #26: When listing and explaining any non-Greek school or professional organizations, make your participation and responsibilities very specific. Those reviewing your application on the Scholarship Committee may not be familiar with the organizations and will need as much information as possible in order to rank your application.

Application Question #27: When listing and describing community service organizations or events, be as specific as possible as it will help in your application ranking.

Application Question #30: Be sure to pay attention to the word limit. We recommend that you write your responses in a Word document, being mindful of spelling, grammar and punctuation. Then, cut and paste your response into the application to be certain nothing is eliminated or overlooked.

Application Question #31: Be specific. We recommend that you write your responses in a Word document, being mindful of spelling, grammar and punctuation. Then, cut and paste your response into the application to be certain nothing is eliminated or overlooked.

Application Question #32: Your personal statement should not be a duplicate of your response in Question #30. We recommend that you write your responses in a Word document, being mindful of spelling, grammar and punctuation. Then, cut and paste your response into the application to be certain nothing is eliminated or overlooked.
